Welcome to the MOSAIC School Fees brochure. Here you will find all the fees related to tuition and services offered throughout the year. To provide you with a simple and transparent overview, these fees are divided into three distinct categories.

1. Compulsory fees

These correspond to the annual school fees associated with your child’s enrolment and educational support. These fees form the basis of the educational programme at our school.

2. Optional costs

These relate to additional services that you can choose according to your needs, such as school meals, the Mosaic Club or other regular services offered by the school.

3. Occasional requests

These include one-off services used according to your family’s needs: exceptionally a meal in the canteen, last-minute childcare or any other unforeseen need, and are billed on a case-by-case basis.

The purpose of this brochure is to enable you to easily identify the costs associated with your child’s school life and to adapt your choice of services with complete peace of mind.

Compulsory fees:

1. Mosaic registration fees are the admission fees due at the time of enrolment. They are only payable once for the entire duration of the child’s schooling.

2. Mandatory tuition fees represent the financial contribution necessary for the proper operation of the institution. They make it possible to offer your child a rich, stimulating, and high-quality school environment. A 5% discount on annual tuition applies if it is paid in a single payment by July 15. Families benefit from a 20% discount on tuition starting from the third child. No discount is granted if tuition for one or more children in the family is paid by a company.

3. The annual fees cover all educational activities for the current academic year. These fees include school supplies and other teaching materials.

They also include:

- School trips: 2 artistic outings per year.
- A cohesion day, for which only meal costs are charged additionally. This experience plays an important role in our educational program: it strengthens bonds between students and encourages their independence.
- Various sports programs, adapted to their age, thanks to our partnership with a sports center.
- An ambitious digital project aimed at preparing our students for constantly evolving technological tools.
- A Health and Well-being Coordinator (Pastoral Care), supported by our designated physician, who accompanies students in their development. She implements activities in the classroom and coordinates the intervention of external specialists when necessary.

4. Mandatory trips

Residential discovery trips, which are mandatory from Grade 5P to Grade 9, are not included in the fees listed above.

For Grade 9 students, the international camp will cost a maximum of CHF 1 500.

5. iPad Purchase

The acquisition of an iPad is planned for a period of three years. A new device will be provided at the beginning of Grade 9. If a student leaves during this three-year period, it will be possible to purchase the iPad according to the terms that will be communicated.

Optional costs:

2. Optional costs include all complementary services that you may choose according to your needs, such as school catering or other regular services offered by the institution.

The prices shown are per day for the trimester/year; simply multiply them by the number of days per week selected to obtain the total annual price.

For example: 3 days of school lunch cost CHF 2,670 per year, supervision included.

The amounts indicated are presented per trimester, along with the corresponding annual total.

CANTEEN

The school cafeteria offers Fourchette Verte certified meals every day, consisting of a starter, a hot main course, a dessert, and bread, ensuring a balanced and high-quality diet.

Meal times are supervised by adults, ensuring a calm environment and a real break time, with the possibility of going to Parc Bertrand.

Middle school students are allowed to leave the premises to eat out if you give them permission to do so.

Menus are available on the school's website.

Particular attention is given to respecting everyone's dietary needs so that each student can have lunch safely and with enjoyment.

SUPERVISED STUDY - permanence

From Grade 9 onward, students have access to the school's study spaces under the supervision of an adult. This supervised study session is organized every day after classes for a duration of one hour.
